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6. The petitioner has proved his case by a preponderance of probabilities and has prima facie established that his non-appearance was beyond his control. The petitioner on his own came before this Court, undertaking to attend the trial and deposit Rs.20,000/- in the Poor Patient Welfare Fund, PGIMER, Chandigarh.
7. Given above, the order dated 16.05.2025 (Annexure P-6) is set aside, subject to the conditions that petitioner shall appear before the trial Court on or before 05.09.2025 at 11.00 AM and also deposit Rs.20,000/- in the account of Poor Patient Welfare Fund, PGIMER, Chandigarh and handover the receipt in the trial Court while appearing. It is further clarified that petitioner shall attend each and every date of hearing before the trial Court, and in case of any exigencies, he shall take exemption from the trial Court. Consequent upon the appearance of petitioner before trial Court, his bonds shall stand restored.
8. If the petitioner fails to appear before the concerned court within the time limit mentioned in this order, then this order shall stand recalled automatically under section 403 read with 528 of BNSS, 2023, without any further reference to this court on 05.09.2025 at 11 AM.
9. Any observation made hereinabove is neither an expression of opinion on the case's merits nor shall the trial Court advert to these comments.
10. *A certified copy of this order would not be needed, and any Advocate for the Petitioner can download this order along with case status from the official web page of this Court and attest it to be a true copy. If the concerned court/ officer wants to verify its authenticity, such an officer can also verify its authenticity and may download and use the downloaded copy for attesting bonds.*
11. Petition is allowed to the extent mentioned above. All pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
