SUBHAS MEHLA, J (Oral):

1. The prayer in the instant criminal writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 to 4 to take an appropriate action against respondents No.6 to 12 who are harassing and threatening the petitioners and their family by interfering in their peaceful life and liberty; with further directions to the official respondents No.2 to 4 to decide representation dated 06.08.2025 (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that petitioners apprehend threat to their life and liberty from the hands of private respondents No. 6 to 12. On 05.08.2025, private respondents came to the house of petitioners, apart from creating a scene they abused the petitioners and regarding which, they moved a representation dated 06.08.2025 (Annexure P-2) and prayed for protection of their life and liberty.

3. On advance notice, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G. Punjab, submitted that the competent authority will look into the matter and will



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take appropriate action in accordance with law.

4. Heard.

5. Keeping in view the facts narrated by the petitioners and submissions made by the State counsel, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.4-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the grievance and take appropriate steps within one month in accordance as per law.
