SUMEET GOEL, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ, order or direction to the official respondents to provide adequate security to the petitioners as they are facing serious threats from respondent Nos.8 and 9.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners limits his prayer and submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, for the *nonce*, if a direction is issued to respondent No.6 to consider and take a conscious decision on the representation (Annexure P-10) made by the petitioners in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the strength of the advance notice, Mr. Gurpartap S. Bhullar, AAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. He submits he has no objection in case the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, at this stage, is accepted.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the rival parties and have perused the paper-book with their assistance.

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6. Keeping in view the entirety of facts and circumstances of the case & without going into merits thereof, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Fatehgarh Sahib (respondent No.6 herein) to look into the representation (Annexure P-10) moved by the petitioners; objectively consider the grievance(s) raised in the said representation & take ratiocinated decision thereupon after affording opportunity of hearing to petitioners, in accordance with law, within a period of three weeks from today. Such decision be communicated to the petitioners within fifteen days of it being taken.

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
