1. Present writ petition was filed in the year 2024 wherein, objection was raised by the Registry and thereafter, no one has bothered to clear the said objection and the incomplete petition is still pending with the Registry of this Court and the same has been listed so as to weed out the same as the petition is consuming limited space available.
