Learned counsel for the parties agree that in pursuance to the order dated 24.09.2024 passed by this Court in the main writ petition, a speaking order has been passed by the respondent-State and even the contempt petition filed, has been disposed of and the speaking order so passed has already been impugned by way of filing CWP-22718-2025, titled as **Manpreet Kaur Dhillon and another vs. State of Punjab and others** which is pending consideration before the Single Bench of this Court.
