The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under article 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer that this Hon'ble Court may issue a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the benefit of equal pay for equal work as admitted by respondents No. 1 to 5 in their written statement and further direction be given to respondent No. 6 for deciding the claim of the petitioners while decided claim petition on merits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that he has filed a claim petition (Annexure P-8) in the Office of Labour Inspector, Ambala which has not been accepted in the Registry of Industrial Tribunal but later on, file the same through registered post while supporting the said petition vide Annexure P-9 i.e. postal receipt to that effect.

Learned counsel confines his prayer seeking a direction to Labour Inspector, Haryana as well as the Industrial Tribunal constituted



under the Industrial Disputes Act to consider and decide the said claim petition in accordance with law, which is not even being processed so far despite having posted the same on 03.05.2025.

The Labour Inspector, Ambala is directed to consider and decide the claim petition as has been prayed for.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
