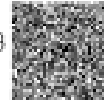

HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. By this common order, 07 Letters Patent Appeals, the details of which have been given in the heading, are being disposed of as all these appeals involve the same question of law on similar facts.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the appellant(s) submits that as there is delay in releasing the amount which was due to State Government but keeping in view the directions given, the amount of interest has already been paid to the employees by the appellant(s) hence, the present appeals may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the appellant(s) to avail appropriate remedy before the appropriate forum for reimbursement of the

amount paid as interest which has been paid by the appellant(s) as the

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liability to pay the said amount on account of interest was only on the authority which has delayed the release of the payment and in the present case according to the appellant(s), the delay was attributable to the State.
