SUBHAS MEHLA, J (Oral):

1. Petitioners have filed present petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India seeking issuance of writ to official respondents No.2 and 3 for protecting life and liberty of petitioners, from the hands of private respondent Nos.4 to 8 and not to harass them in any manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has apprehension of threat from the private respondent Nos.4 to 8 and they have already moved a representation to SSP, Batala, but no action has been taken.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G. Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and submitted that on representation of the petitioners, the competent authority will take action as per law.

5. In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the representation submitted on behalf of the petitioners in accordance with law.

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6. However, it is made clear that if any offence against the State or any individual is committed by the petitioners, this order would create no impediment or bar on taking legal action against the petitioners.
