1. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that with regard to prayer No.1, i.e. for transfer of Investigation to Crime Branch, and the second prayer with regard to direction to respondent No. 4 to 6, for not calling the petitioners and their family members by the police for the purpose of investigation, have already become infructuous, as investigation in this case has already been completed and the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been submitted.
2. With regard to other prayers, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that he has instructions to withdraw the present petition with liberty to seek alternative remedy as available to him in accordance with law.
