Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.158 dated 21.07.2024, under Sections 125, 351(2), 351(3), 191(3), 190 of BNS, 2023 and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar Rural (Annexure P-1).

Vide order dated 13.01.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance to the order passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI, Rashpal Singh has stated that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 13.01.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023. Petition stands allowed.
