1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.253 dated 08.08.2025 under Sections 109, 118(1), 115(2), 126, 351(3) and 61(2) of BNS, registered at Police Station City Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

2. On 27.08.2025, following order was passed:-

“Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.253 dated 08.08.2025 under Sections 109, 118(1), 115(2), 126, 351(3) and 61(2) of BNS, registered at Police Station City Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. Even the injury attributed to the petitioner has been declared simple in nature. He has submitted that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the investigation.

Ms. Gagandeep Kaur, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and seeks time to file status report. Mr. I.S. Deol, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the complainant and filed his Memo of Appearance.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/ Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482(2) BNSS.”

- 3. Today, learned State counsel has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 27.08.2025 and is no longer required for further investigation.
- 4. In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 27.08.2025, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
- 5. Disposed of.
- 6. Pending misc application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
