1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari quashing the impugned Show Cause Notices no. 2-2024/29840 dated 28.11.2024 (Annexure P/13) served upon petitioner being wholly illegal, arbitrary, unjust and unfair as the issue already stands decided by the Respondent/State in dated 08.05.2024 (Annexure P-5) and 19.01.2024 (Annexure P-6) respectively, and the said Orders have been stayed by this Hon'ble Court vide Order Annexure P-9 dated 25.01.2024.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that the issue raised in the present writ petition is squarely covered by the judgment of this Court in *Surya Sangwan vs. State of Haryana and another, CWP No. 31692 of 2024, decided on 29.07.2025*. It is further submitted that the petitioner(s) would be satisfied, at this stage, if a direction is issued to the respondent-State to consider

and decide the claim of the petitioner, as raised in the present petition, in light of the aforesaid judgment, by passing a reasoned and speaking order within a stipulated time frame.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Sushil Bhardwaj, Addl. AG. Haryana, having served with an advance copy of the petition, has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent/State and he has no objection to the above said request.

5. Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of. The competent authority of the respondent-State is directed to treat the present writ petition as a representation and decide the petitioner's claim by passing a reasoned and speaking order, strictly in accordance with law, taking into consideration the facts pleaded in the petition and the judgment rendered by this Court in *Surya Sangwan (supra)*.

6. The entire exercise shall be completed within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order along with a copy of the writ petition and all accompanying annexures.

7. Ordered accordingly.
