The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant/release all the benefits to the petitioner as per clause 11 of the Teachers Transfer Policy, 2016, dated 01.06.2017 and 13.04.2022, Annexures P-1 and P-2 respectively, (amended from time to time).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to decide his pending legal notice, dated 25.06.2025, Annexure P-3, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Amit Sahni, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State, and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 25.06.2025, will be decided by respondent no.2/Director General,

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Elementary School Education, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of three months.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
