1. Prayer in CRM-M-50965 is for quashing of FIR No.177 dated 16.10.2023 under Sections 323, 324, 506 and 34 of the IPC and in CRM-M-50973-2024 is for quashing of cross case bearing GD No.29 dated 16.10.2023 under Sections 341, 323, 506, 34 of the IPC (Section 326 of the IPC added lateron) in the aforementioned FIR registered at Police Station Balongi, District SAS Nagar and all consequential

proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise arrived at, between the parties.

2. Vide order dated 15.10.2024 of this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 14.11.2024 to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise arrived at, between them.

3. Report has since been received from learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kharar, in pursuance of the directions of this Court, wherein, the factum of the compromise arrived at between the parties stands verified and confirmed. As per the report compromise has indeed been effected between the parties and the same is without any pressure or coercion and out of their free will and the complainants have also made statements to the effect that they would have no objection if the FIR/GD *qua* the accused-petitioners is quashed.

4. The Trial Court has annexed copies of statements of the parties alongwith its report.

5. In view of the report of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kharar and the principles laid down by Hon'ble the Apex Court in ***Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303***, and also by the Full Bench of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052***, both the petitions are allowed. The aforesaid FIR and cross case GD and all consequential proceedings arising out of it, are quashed qua petitioners.

6. Needless to say the parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise and their statements recorded before the Court below.
