DEEPINDER SINGH NALWA, J. (Oral)

1. In the present petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance of direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner under Section 47 of the Persons with Disability (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation), Act, 1995 and to grant all service benefits to the petitioner (as he was entitled before him getting disable) as a regular employee till the age of superannuation.

2. Reply by way of counter affidavit of the Additional Superintending Engineer, DS, Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd., City Division, Ferozepur Cantt. on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 has been filed in Court today, which is taken on record.

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3. Learned counsel for the respondents No.1 to 4, while relying upon memo dated 03.03.2023⁴ (Annexure R-2), submits that in fact the petitioner will be treated as a regular employee and will be paid salary till the age of superannuation. He further submits that the necessary order will also be passed within a period of 4 weeks today.
4. In view of the statement given by learned counsel for the respondents No.1 to 4, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing survives in the present petition and he does not want to press the same.
5. Disposed of as having not been pressed. However, if any cause still survives, the petitioner is at liberty to file an appropriate application for revival of the petition.
6. Pending application(s), if any, also stand(s) disposed of.
