1. The present petition has been filed against the judgment dated 29.02.2022 passed by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Panchkula whereby appeal of the appellant has been dismissed against the judgment dated 09.01.2020 passed by learned trial Court whereby the accused has been acquitted in case FIR No. 187 dated 14.06.2013 under Section 323, 498-A and 34 IPC registered at Police Station City Mandi Dabwali.
