KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

1. Through the instant writ petition, as cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a Certiorari is prayed for, to quash the letters dated 10.01.2025 (Annexure P-2), 09.04.2025 (Annexure P-3), 15.04.2025 (Annexure P-4 to P-6), vide which, claim of the petitioners for stepping up their pay with their juniors, has been declined. A Mandamus is also prayed for, commanding the respondent authorities, for stepping up the pay of the petitioners with their juniors.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for respondents No.1 and 2, on instructions, submits that claim of the petitioners will be decided by the competent authority, by passing a speaking order, within a period of eight weeks from the date of passing of the order.



3. Learned counsel for the petitioners is in agreement with the course suggested by learned counsel for respondents No.1 and 2, and submits that let this petition be disposed of, in terms of the statement made by her.
4. In view of the above statements made by learned counsel for the parties, the instant writ petition is accordingly **disposed of**.
