Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to the respondents to transfer the investigation of the case FIR No.64, dated 29.03.2025 under Sections 21, 27, 29 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga, to Central Bureau of Investigation or any independent agency or SIT to be constituted not below the rank of a Senior Superintendent of Police.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely roped in by the respondents in four different FIRs. It is submitted that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has filed representation, no action has been taken thereon.

Notice of motion.

Mr. J.S. Arora, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. On instructions from ASI Jaswant Singh, at the outset, he has submitted that investigation in FIR No.64 is already complete and challan is also presented. However, representation filed by the petitioner has not been dealt with so far.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, to decide the representation dated 15.07.2025 (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioner within a period of four weeks from today, in accordance with law.
