1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.67 dated 28.05.2024, registered under Sections 323, 324, 452, 427, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Cantt. District Jalandhar.

2. By virtue of order dated 16.10.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated with the same and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

4. Status report by way of affidavit of Barjinder Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (Cantt), Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar filed in Court is taken on record. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satwinder Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 16.10.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
