AARADHNA SAWHNEY, J. (ORAL)

1. Present petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 has been filed by the petitioners praying therein to direct the official respondents not to entertain any frivolous complaint of respondent Nos.5 to 10. It has further been prayed to direct the official respondents not to call the petitioners on the basis of the complaint dated 18.08.2025.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the private respondent Nos.5 to 10 have filed as many as 16 complaints on the same cause of action. Even in the present complaint similar allegations have been levelled. Earlier complaints were inquired into by the police authorities and finding no substance in the same, they were filed. Learned counsel further submits that the present complaint also stems out of the same cause of action, however, official respondents are hell bent to harass the petitioners by repeatedly calling them to the police station.

Learned counsel limits his prayer to direct official respondents to

decide the representation (Annexure P-8) of the petitioners at the earliest.

- 4. Ms. Shweta Nahata, DAG, Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of the State.
- 5. Without commenting upon the merits of the case and in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Hisar to decide the representation dated 24.08.2025 (Annexure P-1) expeditiously.
- 6 Disposed of accordingly.
