This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus to the respondents directing to grant retiral benefits i.e. GPF, Gratuity, leave encashment etc. and thereafter pension month after month.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider the legal notice dated 14.07.2025 (Annexure P- 5) within a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Sushil Bhardwaj, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and assures the Court that the

legal notice dated 14.07.2025 (Annexure P- 5) shall be decided by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.

5. In view of the above, and without adverting to the merits of the case, the respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner/Collector, Jind, District Jind is directed to consider and decide the representation legal notice dated 14.07.2025 (Annexure P- 5), after providing opportunity of hearing to the parties, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within seven days thereafter.

7. Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
