KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. The main grievance which propelled the present petitioner to approach this Court by casting instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is the indolent and lackadaisical approach of the authority concerned, in not deciding his complaint dated 24.02.2025 (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied, in case a *mandamus* is passed upon respondent authorities, to take a final decision on his complaint (*supra*), in a time bound manner.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that he has no objection, if such a direction is passed upon the respondent authorities.

4. In view of the above, considering the prayer, as made by learned counsel for the petitioner, being innocuous and *bona fide*, this Court, without observing anything on the merits of the instant case, directs respondents authorities concerned, to take a final decision on the complaint (*supra*), by passing a speaking order, within a period of four weeks from today.

5. **Disposed of** accordingly.
