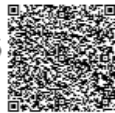

JASGURPREET SINGH PURI J.(Oral)

1. All the learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that the present petition has become infructuous in view of the fact that the tenure of the Managing Committee has already expired in November 2024.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, however, submitted that the dispute was with regard to the defective voter list and prayed that he may be granted permission to file a complaint/representation to the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, UT Chandigarh and that the Registrar may be directed to consider the same in accordance with law and pass an order.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent–UT Chandigarh submits that in the event of the petitioners filing any such complaint/representation with regard to the defectiveness of the voter list, the same shall be considered strictly in accordance with law and an appropriate order shall be passed after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners or their counsel, as early as possible
