Keeping in view the averments made in the application, the representation/complaint dated 22.07.2025 is taken on record as Annexure P-5 and the same is allowed to be substituted with existing Annexure P-2 subject to all just exceptions.

Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.

Main Case

1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner who is a Non-Resident Indian (NRI) from threats and intimidations extended through cyber calling from unknown internet generated numbers. It is stated in the petition that the petitioner has already made representation dated 23.07.2025



(Annexure P-1) before the NRI Affairs Cell, Punjab Police Headquarters, Sector-9, Chandigarh and representation dated 22.07.2025 (Annexure P-5) to the Commissioner of Police, District Jalandhar raising the said grievances, but no action has been taken so far.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, District Jalandhar to consider the aforesaid representation (Annexure P-5) filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Ravinder Singh, DAG Punjab, who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course.

5. In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 22.07.2025 (Annexure P-5) within a period of 30 days from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
