This writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant the petitioner all the admissible benefits of previous service rendered by her husband with the Border Security Force, Govt. of India, w.e.f. 01.09.1970 to 06.11.1984, towards his qualifying service for pensionary benefits along with all consequential benefits.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to respondents No.1 and 2 to consider the legal notice dated 12.11.2024 (Annexure P- 21) within a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Sushil Bhardwaj, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and assures the Court that the legal notice dated 12.11.2024 (Annexure P- 21) shall be decided by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
5. In view of the above, and without advertng to the merits of the case, the respondents No. 1 and 2 are directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 12.11.2024 (Annexure P- 21), after providing opportunity of hearing to the parties, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
6. A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within seven days thereafter.
7. Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
