1. This Court on the last date of hearing, i.e. 28.08.2025, passed the hereinafter extracted order:-

“This case has been taken up out turn on request of learned counsel for respondent no.1-High Court.

He informs this Court that, in fact, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous, as post disciplinary inquiry, the order of punishment has already been passed on dated 23.07.2025.

Today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Adjourned to 29.08.2025.

2. Today, learned counsel for the petitioner has caused appearance, and fairly, submits that now the disciplinary proceedings
