1. The present civil writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* for directing the respondents for revising the last pay drawn by the petitioner in the service of respondent-PUDA as Assistant Engineer (Civil) as on 31.01.2016 and to pay the various retiral benefits to the petitioner on the basis of such revised last pay drawn by him in terms of the circular dated 29.11.2021 (Annexure P-7) issued by the State Government.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if the demand notice-cum-representation (Annexure P-11) of the petitioner is decided by the respondents by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the respondents are directed to consider the demand notice-cum-representation (Annexure P-11) of the petitioner in light of the judgments passed by this Court in CWP No.1692 of 2017 titled as 'Dr. Dharampal Vs.

State of Haryana and others' and CWP No.26164 of 2015 titled as 'Jarnail Singh Vs. Punjab Water Supply & Sewerage Board' (Annexures P-8 & P-9, respectively) and pass a speaking order, after affording him an opportunity to be heard, within a period of 03 months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order. Further, the decision taken thereof shall be conveyed to the petitioner. Needless to say, if the petitioner is found entitled to the relief sought, the same shall be granted forthwith by the respondents.

4. Disposed of, accordingly.
