1. Reply to the writ petition filed by respondents No.5 to 9, today in the Court, is taken on the record.
2. In view of the contentions raised in paragraph 5 of the reply to instant writ petition filed by respondents No.1 to 3 – State, paragraph whereof become extracted hereinafter, therebys, a direction is passed upon the respondent concerned, to make forthwith compliance therewiths.

“5. That the answering respondent are following due process of law and are ready to pay the compensation as per law



for the land in question, keeping in view the larger public interest because a large number of people are in need of the said road for their daily day to day work. The compensation of the land in question will be accessed as per law.”

3. In view of the above extracted paragraph carried in the reply filed to the instant writ petition by respondents No.1 to 3 – State, the learned counsel for respondents No.5 to 9 submits, that on the subsequent date of hearing, thus the civil appeal as directed against the declining decree passed, on the suit for possession relating to the instant subject khasra numbers, rather shall be withdrawn.

4. Disposed of accordingly, alongwith all pending applications, if any.

5. It is clarified that the subject road shall be a signature road. The said road, be ensured to be completed within six months, i.e. before the ensuing monsoons. However, repair work over the subject road be forthwith undertaken.
