Petitioner has filed instant petition for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 to 4 to ensure that no multiple inquiry is conducted in the repeated complaints filed by respondents No. 7 and 8 as the matter has already been inquired into the two earlier complaints filed by respondents No. 7 and 8.

Status report dated 27.11.2024 filed by learned State counsel is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at the appropriate place.

Learned State counsel at the very outset submits that nothing survives in the present petition as the veracity of the allegations made by respondents No. 7 and 8 were thoroughly examined and it has been concluded that the dispute between the parties is purely civil in nature and the complaint made by respondents No. 7 and 8 has been ordered to be consigned to record as no truth has been found in the allegations made by them.
