1. Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent Nos.1 and 2 to conduct a departmental proceedings against respondent No.4 in view of the inquiry conducted by Vigilance Bureau, Punjab.
