1. Challenge in the instant petition is to the rejection order dated 16.09.2023 whereby the claim of the petitioner, for seeking compassionate appointment, has been rejected.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents, however, contends that he has received a communication dated 05.08.2025 bearing No.RO/HCM/2025-26-297 and that the respondent(s)-Department is reconsidering the claim of the petitioner on merits without being influenced by the earlier decisions passed. He further contends that certain documents, including copy of the Pension Payment Order (PPO) of late Shri Ravinder Kumar, Ex-staff, has been sought for. He submits that in the event of the petitioner submitting the requisite documents having been called for, the appropriate decision as per law and applicable policy, shall be taken by the respondents within a period of three months



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of submitting of such documents.

3. In view of the above, the instant petition is **disposed of** with a direction to the respondents to reconsider the claim of the petitioner in terms of the communication dated 05.08.2025 and to pass appropriate orders as per law within a period of three months of the petitioner supplying the requisite documents to the respondents for consideration of his claim.
