1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, seeking issuance of direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the appeal dated 23.12.2024 (Annexure P-9) filed by respondent No. 4 in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the appeal dated 23.12.2024 (Annexure P-9) filed by respondent No. 4 in relation to mutation No. 1458, Village Mandala, Tehsil Khadoor Sahib, District Tarn Taran has been finally argued and the matter was fixed for orders on various dates and presently, the same stands adjourned to 03.09.2025 and the petitioner would be satisfied, if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the same in a time bound manner.
