The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release monthly pension to the petitioner along with arrears with effect from 26.04.2018, as already approved by Executive Council (EC) of the respondent University vide resolution dated 12.07.2024.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that despite the EC resolution aforementioned, monthly pension of the petitioner has not been released on the ground some clarification from the Director, Local Audit, Chandigarh, is awaited, as conveyed to him vide letter dated 08.07.2025, Annexure P-11.



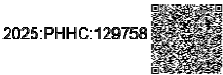
3. Learned State counsel has shown a copy of memo, dated 15.09.2025, received from the Directorate of Local Audit Haryana, whereby a memo issued by Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, Finance Department, dated 12.09.2025, has been forwarded to Joint Director (Audit) of the University. The memo by Additional Chief Secretary is to the following effect:

2. It is informed that the subject matter relates to GJUS&T University which falls under the Technical Education Department. The subject matter is to be allowed/rejected on the basis of the rules/instructions of Universities. You are hereby requested to direct the concerned Joint Director to inform the reasons for tendering the advice opinion in absence of any relevant rule instructions as every comments provided must be given indicating the relevant rules & instructions.

3. It is further directed that if any irregularity is found during the audit of audittee institute/University, the same may be sought from the Head Office/Administrative Department of concerned audittee institute. If, presently any such clarification is pending with your Department, the same may be got clarified from the Head Office/Administrative Department of concerned audittee institute.

3.1. She further submits Joint Director, Local Audit, vide letter dated 16.09.2025, has requested the University Registrar that clarification regarding switching over the mode of pro-rata pension, i.e., non-recurring to recurring, may be sought from the Head Office/Administrative Department of Technical Education. Accordingly, now it is for the University to take action in the matter for releasing pension to the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the University submits that appropriate decision in that regard for releasing monthly pension to the petitioner will be taken after adjusting the payment already made to him vide letter dated 15.11.2021, within three months.



- 5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
- 6. Ordered accordingly.
