The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer that this Hon'ble Court may issue a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned Tentative Seniority List of SEPO's as on 01.08.2024 circulated by respondent No.2 vide letter dated 22.08.2024 (Annexure P-7), whereby petitioners have been wrongly placed much lower than their actual entitlement as shown in the present petition; further prayed for issuing a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned letter dated 13.08.2025 (Annexure P-9) issued by respondent No.1 vide which without finalizing seniority of SEPO's records of candidates at Sr. No.1 to 32 in impugned Tentative Seniority List as on 01.08.2025 (Annexure P-7) have been called for promotion to the post of BDPO.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sushil Bhardwaj, Addl. A.G., Haryana appearing on advance notice, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State.

It is submitted that the objections are stated to be pending since 2022 and the same have not been decided.

It is relied upon an earlier order dated 25.08.2025 passed in CWP-24566-2025, the State has taken a stand that without finalizing the tentative Seniority List will not make the consider the case of promotion to the post of B.D.P.O's from SEPO's.

In the light of above, representation dated 23.08.2025 (Annexure P-11) shall be considered and decided by passing a speaking order before making any promotion to the post of BDPO including finalization of Tentative Seniority List, in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. The order so passed shall be furnished to the petitioner within two weeks thereafter.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
