1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 for issuance of a direction to the official respondents restraining him from conducting second enquiry on the complaint No.402047 dated 05.08.2024 moved by respondent No.5 against the petitioners.

2. At the outset, Mr. Vinay Kumar Malhotra, learned DAG, Punjab has submitted on instructions from ASI Bua Singh who is present in the Court that petitioner No.1 and respondent No.5 who are husband and wife have already settled the dispute with each other and therefore, there is neither any requirement for conducting second enquiry nor the same will be conducted by the police. He also submitted that the summons which are issued by the Prevention of Crimes against Woman and Children Cell vide Annexure P-6 would also not be given effect to since the matter has been compromised between the parties.



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3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that in view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the present petition may be dismissed as withdrawn.
