Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has a certificate in Sanitary Inspection and ought to be eligible for the post of Multipurpose Health Worker. The respondents by the impugned notification have restricted the eligibility to Diploma in Multipurpose Health Worker for the said post. He submits that the Course of Sanitary Inspection is at par with the Diploma in Multipurpose Health Worker and several States have accepted the same. He has referred to the Advertisements for the post of Multipurpose Health Worker issued by the States of Gujarat, Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra (Annexures P-6, P-8 and P-9 respectively). He submits that the petitioner has preferred a representation dated 23.08.2025 (Annexure P-3) before respondent No.1 but no action has been taken thereon and respondent No.1 be directed to consider and decide the same in a time bound manner.

2. Issue notice to respondent No.1 only at this stage.
3. At the asking of the Court, Ms. Arundhati Kulshreshtha, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1.
4. Heard.
5. In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the representation dated 23.08.2025 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
