1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner for directions to the respondents No.1 to 3 to take action against the private respondents No.4 and 5, who withheld the passports of 9 persons illegally and also duped the petitioner with a sum of Rs.14,00,000/- on the pretext of providing them VISA initially to Dubai and thereafter collected a sum of Rs.6,00,000/- on the pretext of providing VISA to Cyprus.

2. The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the petitioner has filed a representation dated 26.05.2025 (Annexure P-2) before the respondent No.2-The Commissioner of Police, Amritsar. The learned counsel prays for directions to the respondent No.2 to decide the abovementioned representation within a stipulated time.

3. Notice of motion to the respondents No.1 to 3 only.

4. Since advance notice has already been served upon the State, Mr. Eklavya Darshi, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, and waives service.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a direction for deciding the representation of the petitioner (Annexure P-2) be given to the respondent No.2 and that the instant petition be disposed of accordingly.

6. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.-2-The Commissioner of Police to pass a speaking order and decide the representation of the petitioner (Annexure P-2) on its own merits, as per law, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

7. It is, however, made clear that no finding with regard to merits of the allegations is being recorded vide instant order, and the police authorities shall be at liberty to take an independent decision with regard to contents of the representation.
