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HARSH BUNGER, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India, inter alia, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside order dated 18.03.2025 (Annexure P-7), passed by learned District Judge, Fatehabad in Civil Appeal No. 48 of 2025, whereby the appeal filed by the petitioners under the Public Premises (Eviction of Unauthorized Occupants) Act, 1971, has been dismissed.

2. A perusal of order sheets reveals that on the last three occasions, the matter has been repeatedly adjourned either on the request of learned counsel for petitioners or on account of absence of learned counsel for petitioners.

3. Today again, despite second call, there is no representation on behalf of petitioners. It appears that petitioners are no more interested in pursuing the matter.

4. In view of the above, instant civil writ petition is dismissed for non prosecution.
