1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner. It is stated in the petition that the petitioner has already made representation dated 31.08.2025 (Annexure P-2) before respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sri Muktsar Sahib and respondent No.5-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Fatehabad raising the said grievances, but no action has been taken so far.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sri Muktsar Sahib and respondent No.5-Senior Superintendent of Police,



District Fatehabad to consider the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Ravinder Singh, DAG Punjab, and Mr. Neeraj Sheoran, Sr. DAG Haryana who are present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondents-States and submits that the needful will be done in due course.

5. Mr. Neeraj Sheoran, Sr. DAG Haryana also present in Court submits that the needful will be done in due course.

6. In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sri Muktsar Sahib and respondent No.5-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Fatehabad to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 31.08.2025 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner within a period of 30 days from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
