Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the
Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS') for grant of
concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.98 dated
15.03.2024, registered for offences punishable under Sections 420 & 120-B
of the IPC, 1860, at Police Station Faridabad Central, Faridabad.

2. The petitioner was granted concession of *ad interim*
anticipatory bail on 08.09.2025 and thereafter, another opportunity was
afforded to the petitioner to join investigation, vide order dated 08.10.2025.

3. Learned State counsel (on instructions from Assistant Sub
Inspector Ram Singh) that the petitioner has not joined investigation.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to refute this factual position. He, however, submits that the petitioner be afforded another opportunity to do the needful.
5. This Court finds no reason *nay* plausible reason for grant of another opportunity to the petitioner.
6. In view of the totality of factual *milieu* of the case in hand; especially keeping in view the conduct of the petitioner; this Court is inclined to dismiss the present petition.
7. Ordered accordingly.
8. Needless to say that anything observed herein above shall not be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case.
9. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
