1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 BNSS for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.86 dated 21.07.2025, filed under Section 308(2), 319(2), 318(4), 336(3), 338, 340(2), 61(2) of BNS 2023, registered at Police Station Cyber Crime, Chandigarh.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and prays that his bail application be directed to be decided within a time bound manner.
