The prayer in the instant Criminal Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No. 2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to interfere in their peaceful lives at the behest of respondents No.4 and 5, as well as directing the official respondents to decide representation dated 01.09.2025 (Annexure P-3).

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Subhash Godara, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and submitted that on representation of the petitioners, the competent authority will take action as per law.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala,



Punjab to look into the representation dated 01.09.2025 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law. It is made clear that if they have committed any offence against the State or against any private person, this order will not create any impediment for taking any action in accordance with law.

6. In view of the above, the present Writ Petition is disposed of.
