1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short-'BNSS') for quashing of FIR No.66, dated 07.05.2017 registered under Sections 447, 427, 379 and 34 of IPC (Section 201 of IPC added later on) at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar (Rural), along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 10.09.2024 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

2. This Court vide order dated 22.10.2024 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has submitted report dated 20.11.2024 to the effect that the compromise has been



effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

6. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052* and approved by the Hon’ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303*, this petition is allowed and FIR No.66, dated 07.05.2017 registered under Sections 447, 427, 379 and 34 of IPC (Section 201 of IPC added later on) at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar (Rural) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 10.09.2024 (Annexure P-2) are quashed qua the petitioner.
