1. This is the second petition filed by the petitioner for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.84 dated 17.07.2024 under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sultanwind, Amritsar.

2. Earlier petition bearing CRM-M No.614 of 2025 filed by the petitioner for grant of regular bail came up for hearing on 07.08.2025 and on that date the case was argued at length and then on the request of learned counsel for the petitioner, petition was dismissed being not pressed. Now the present petition has been filed by the petitioner with the similar prayer just after 01 month.

3. However, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the prosecution witnesses despite having been issued bailable warrants, are not appearing before the trial Court.

4. This Court does not find any change in circumstances which would entitle the petitioner for grant of regular bail. Hence, the present petition is dismissed, at this stage. However, the prosecution is directed to ensure the presence of witnesses before the trial Court.
