1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 for issuance of directions to the respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct fair and impartial inquiry in FIR bearing No.40 dated 09.06.2025 registered under Sections 109(1), 304, 115(2), 118, 191(3), 190, 329, 62 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023 and Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Tallewal, District Barnala, wherein, the name of the petitioner has been added through DDR No.11 dated 12.06.2025 by taking into consideration the representation dated 01.07.2025 (Annexure P-3).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is not involved in the matter as he is a neighbourer of respondent Nos.4 and 5, who are cousins. He further contended that the petitioner was trying to resolve their dispute but his name was mentioned in the cross-version on a false narration. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner has moved a

representation dated 01.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, but no action has been taken so far.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepted notice on behalf of respondent-State and submitted that investigation is still pending and one of the co-accused, namely, Harjot Kaur has been found to be innocent and if the petitioner co-operates, the authority will take appropriate action in accordance with law.
5. Heard.
6. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take action in accordance with law.
