JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking directions to respondents to consider and decide their notice dated 16.05.2025.

2. The petitioners joined service during April' 2008 as Constables. The State Government, to remove stagnation introduced, Assured Career Progression ('ACP') Scheme. The petitioners were granted benefit of first ACP Scheme w.e.f. 01.05.2016 i.e. on completion of 8 years' service. They are entitled to benefit of second ACP Scheme w.e.f. 01.05.2024. They have made multiple representations but to no avail. They have served advance notice dated 16.05.2025 upon respondents.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that grievance of the petitioners would be redressed if respondents are directed to decide their notice dated 16.05.2025.

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4. Mr. Ashok Kumar Khubbar, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who on advance notice is present in Court on behalf of respondent-State, assures the Court that competent authority would consider and decide notice of the petitioners within 6 months from today.

5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.
