Appellant has filed the present appeal impugning the order dated 23.09.2024 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rewari, whereby, application for anticipatory bail filed by the appellant in FIR No.138, dated 09.09.2024 under Sections 79, 115, 351(3), 3(5) BNS and Sections 3(2)(v) of SC/ST (POA) Act, 1989, at Police Station Jatusana, District Rewari, has been dismissed.

2. By virtue of order dated 21.10.2024, while granting interim protection, the appellant was directed to join the investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that in pursuance to the order dated 21.10.2024, the appellant has joined the investigation and fully cooperated with the same and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

4. Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the appellant. He has submitted that the appellant is threatening the complainant.

5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Seema

Kumari, has affirmed the fact that the appellant has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

6. In view of the above, the present appeal is allowed and the order dated 21.10.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. However, the State is directed to take into consideration the grievances raised by the complainant with regard to his protection and take appropriate action in accordance with law.
