1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order 29.01.2019 whereby his promotion as Officiating Assistant Sub-Inspector was withdrawn as per policy dated 12.11.2012.

2. The petitioner joined Haryana Police Force as Constable on 29.10.1991. He was part of District Faridabad. He was confirmed as Head Constable in District Faridabad. He was further promoted as Assistant Sub-Inspector and Sub-Inspector. The respondent issued him show cause notice dated 16.11.2018 calling upon to show cause as to why service benefit given to him i.e. List-D w.e.f. 25.01.2011 and order of promotion as Officiating Assistant Sub-Inspector w.e.f. 26.01.2011 should not be withdrawn as he has lien with District Palwal of South Range, Rewari. The petitioner filed reply to show cause notice. The respondent noticed petitioner's reply and vide order dated 29.01.2019 withdrew service benefits i.e. List-D w.e.f.



25.01.2011 and order of promotion as Officiating Assistant Sub-Inspector w.e.f. 26.01.2011. The respondent formed an opinion that he was posted in Police District Rural Faridabad which was later on renamed as District Palwal on 03.01.2006. He was confirmed as Head Constable on 14.03.2006. As per policy dated 07.10.2010 and clarification dated 30.08.2012, all Constables and Head Constables whose parent District was Faridabad and were posted in Rural Faridabad (Palwal) on 03.01.2006 will have their lien with newly created District Rural Faridabad (Palwal).

3. The impugned order was passed on 29.01.2019. The petitioner has preferred instant petition in August’ 2025.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file afresh with better particulars. The petitioner is also at liberty to approach competent authority at Rewari Range with respect to his claim for promotion and seniority.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
