SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under article 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer that this Hon'ble Court may issue a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing of transfer order dated 08.08.2025 (Annexure P.3) passed by respondent No.1 whereby the petitioner, a regularly appointed Sub Divisional Engineer (Civil) has been transferred vice versa with respondent No.3.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the impugned action of the respondent-Department is discriminatory, arbitrary and violative of equality in the eyes of law.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Sushil Bhardwaj, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts of instant case, present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent Nos.1



& 2 to treat the present writ petition as a representation and decide the same by passing a speaking order, strictly adhering to the Policy/Instructions (Annexure P.2) as applicable in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Copy of which shall be furnished to the petitioner within next three days thereafter.

6. Learned State counsel is directed to convey a copy of this order along with a copy of the writ petition to the Competent Authority for necessary action.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
