1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 for issuance of directions to the respondents No.1 to 4 to investigate the matter and register the FIR against the respondent No. 6.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner moved a representation (Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda regarding filing of false complaints and threat by respondent No.6, but no action has been taken on the representation by respondent No.3 and 4.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Satyapal Jain, Addl. Solicitor General of India (through video conferencing) assisted by Mr. Akash Vashisth, Advocate has appeared on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 and 5 and stated that there is no grievance against the said respondents.
5. Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab has appeared on behalf of respondent Nos. 2 to 4 and submits that representation of the petitioner will be dealt with in accordance with law and Competent Authority shall take appropriate action.
6. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the present

petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the matter and take action in accordance with law, if so required in a time bound manner preferably within a period of two months from today.
